### **Program Overview:**

The UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Neonatal and Pediatric ECLS Educational Conference is a 2.5-day course designed to provide a didactic and "hands-on" based education in an interactive multidisciplinary format for health care providers who care for patients receiving extracorporeal support.
