ACHP's social needs assessment project revealed three profiles that characterize ACHP plans' approaches to social needs, as well as specific opportunities for building sustainable, data-driven approaches. Designed to be highly interactive, this session will feature Spring Street Exchange and your fellow ACHP members in discussion about key findings from the ACHP assessment. Sharing by ACHP plans will focus on using social needs data to understand and target utilization and cost of care, understanding social needs on the individual and population levels, and defining key performance indicators to measure success.
