This educational seminar will be presented to provide fundamental information necessary for a comprehensive approach to the early recognition and diagnosis of oral cancer. This is intended to improve the practitioner's ability to provide long-term post treatment care of the oral cancer patient.

## OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this seminar, participants should be able to:

- Review the principles of dental care in the patient with oral cavity and oropharyngeal cancer.
- Recognize the importance of screening for oral cavity cancer and be able to perform the screening at each dental encounter.
- Identify causes and patients at risk for oral cavity and oropharyngeal cancer.
- Explain how radiation and chemotherapy are used in the treatment of oral cavity cancer and their acute and chronic post-treatment effects.
- Recognize the challenges of post treatment dysphagia and osteoradionecrosis.
- Identify strategies and options to help patients stop smoking.
