Overview of the HealthChoices Maternal Home Visiting Program

- New requirement for evidenced-informed home visits in 2021
- Objective of the home visiting program is to improve maternal and infant health outcomes and reduce maternal and infant morbidity and mortality, especially in individuals identified to be at risk
- Home visits for all first-time parents, parents/caregivers of infants with additional risk factors and any infant and their parent/caregiver
 - In addition to already required postpartum visits



- Home visiting services must be available from the prenatal period through the child's first 18 months of life.
- Assessments must include maternal, infant and family needs and risks – including focus on social, racial, economic and environmental factors
- Programs must be individualized, strengths-based and family focused to ensure all needs are addressed and families are active partners in their care



- Requirements for home visitors
 - Licensed and/or non-licensed staff with an emphasis on expanding the use of non-licensed providers
 - Meet the requirements of nationally recognized home visiting programs
 - Knowledgeable of community resources
- For families who decline, the PH-MCO is to reach out to the parent/caregiver every 90 days
- Home visiting services must be initiated as soon as parent/caregiver agrees to the first visit, but no more than fourteen (14) calendar days.



- In-person visits are preferred; telehealth for specified situations
- Encouraging MCOs to work on expansion and capacity building of existing evidenced-based home visiting programs
