GOALS

What are the goals of the program?

- This program should always maintain a low barrier to access to substance use treatment
- Multidisciplinary team (physicians, APP's, social work team) provide consultation services at every AHN hospital (ED + Inpatient Consults)
- Develop easy to access outpatient MOUD clinics nearby corresponding hospital services
- Navigate individuals who use substances to appropriate services (treatment across ASAM continuum, social services, benefits, housing, etc)
- Provide education, training, and advocacy on behalf of services geared toward individuals who use substances.
