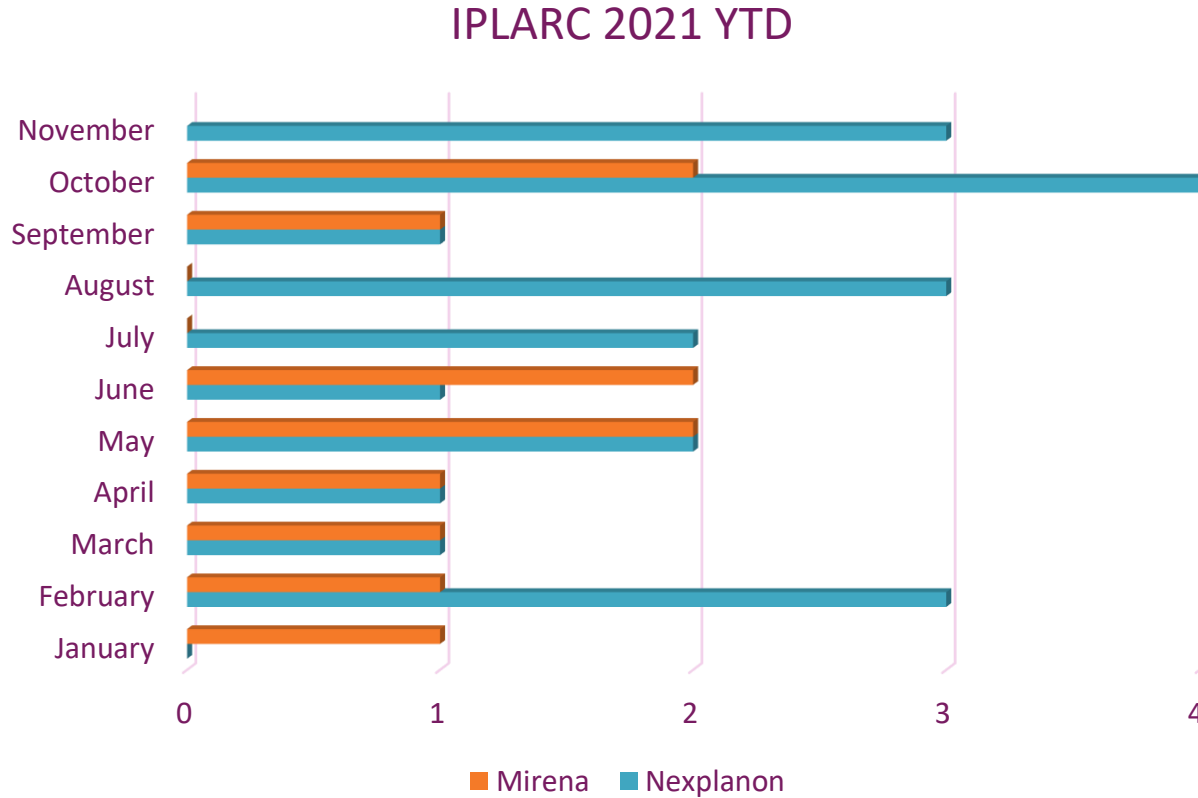
Team Goals

- Reduce maternal mortality and morbidity while improving care for postpartum women
- Increase access to IPLARC among eligible women desiring IPLARC
- Increase patient options for immediate postpartum long-acting reversible contraception
 - Nexplanon
 - Mirena
 - Paragard

Key Interventions

- Collaborated with Inpatient Pharmacy to add Mirena and Paragard on formulary
- Met with Director of Corporate Compliance and Revenue Analysis to assure payment and financial process
- Obtain monthly IPLARC reports from Inpatient Pharmacy Manager
- Staff and provider education

Results Continued...

- Mostly related to Nexplanon
- Satisfactory arrangement with Pharmacy
- Challenges ahead:
 - Data incomplete: need to capture how many women want IPLARC? What is the total that we think would benefit based on prenatal assessment? How many of the ones who want it/request it then get IPLARC?
 - Clearly identify, of the women who get IPLARC, how many are at risk re: SUD or NAS?
 - IUD Training: some reticence on part of providers to insert
 - Explore concerns- Expulsion? Time constraints?
 - Nexplanon: some reticence on part of providers to implant
 - Explore concerns
 - Insurance remains a challenge, but we are minimizing impact
