Over 60 percent of the heroin that is sold in the United States originates in the poppy fields of Southeast Asia. Opium poppies in Colombia.




New Psychoactive Substances (NPS)

 - Nearly impossible to police


















Fentanyl-mixed Heroin in Pittsburgh



Opioids

- Testing
 - Routine urine drug tests detect morphine and heroin
 - Cannot detect many synthetics (i.e. tramadol, methadone, fentanyl)

Synthetic Cannibinoids • Pharmacology - Not much is known - However. . . Potency = THC << CHMINACA << HU-210

































2C-x Compounds
