

 - Present findings to cohort

PA CHW Certification Requirements

Education/Training

75 total hours of education from a PCB accredited CHW training program gained with the last five years.

Work Experience

One year of full-time volunteer or paid employment (or 2000 hours of part-time) as a CHW.

Current Job Description

Copy of current CHW volunteer/job description, obtained from current organization, and which must be signed by both the applicant and their immediate supervisor.

On-the-job Supervision

60 hours of on-the-job supervision of qualifying work experience specific to the domains*.

Certification Fee

\$50 (fee must accompany application and materials)



Timeline

CCHW credentials are valid for 2 calendar years from the date of issuance





CCHWs must have a minimum of 30 hours relevant to community health including 3 hours of ethics
