## WHO ARE OUR PARTNERS AND WHAT ARE OUR CORE PROGRAMS?



#### TITLE I

WIOA Title I assists adults by providing individualized career and access to demand driven training services.

The WIOA Title I Dislocated Worker program helps workers, before or after a layoff, get back to work as quickly as possible.

The WIOA Title I Youth program it serves eligible youth and young adults, ages 14—24, who face barriers to education, training, and employment.

#### TITLE II

WIOA Title II assists adults in becoming literate, and helps individuals learn the English language. It supports adults in preparing for a high school equivalency exam, and in the transition to post-secondary education and training.

#### TITLE III

WIOA Title III employment services provide access to a variety of services including job search, job referrals, labor market information and placement assistance; and re-employment services are available for unemployment insurance claimants. It offers employer services such as assistance with job orders, job matching, job fairs, and recruitment needs.

#### TITLE IV

WIOA Title IV
Rehabilitation Act
Services, in Pennsylvania,
known as the Office of
Vocational Rehabilitation
