
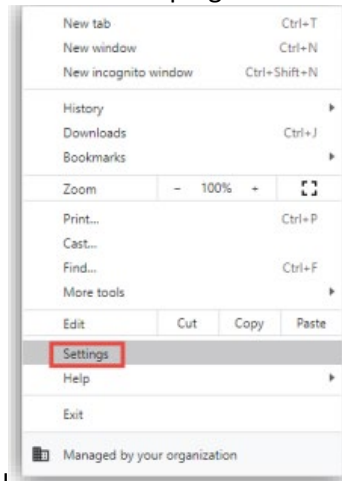
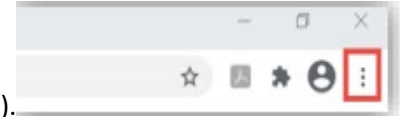


# You MUST have Administrative Rights on your Computer to disable your Pop-up Blocker

## How to disable Pop-up blocker using Chrome:

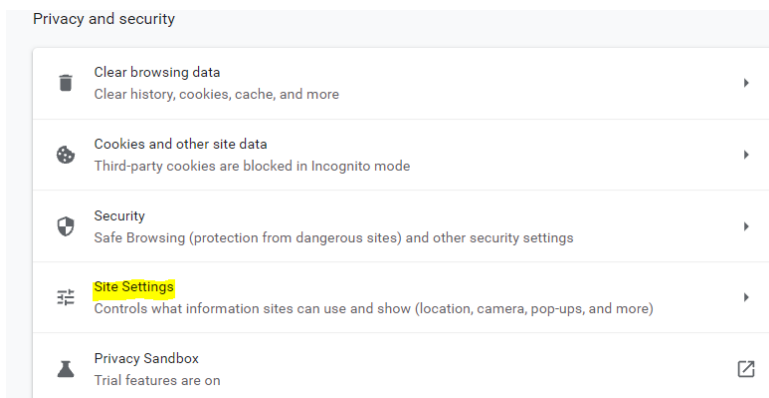
1. On your computer, open Chrome .

2. Click **More** (3 vertical dots next to profile icon at the top right of the screen).

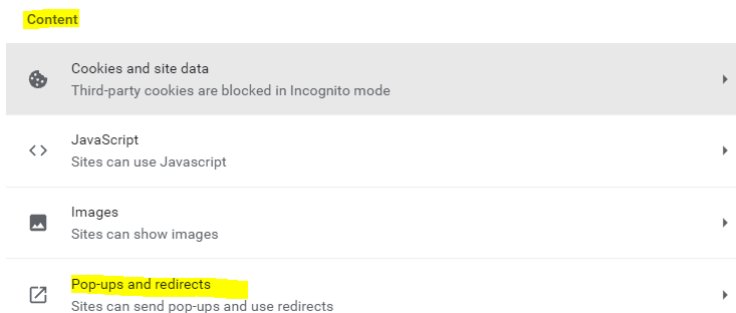


3. Select **Settings** from the dropdown menu.

4. Scroll to "**Privacy and security**" heading and click **Site Settings**.



5. Scroll to **Content**, select arrow next to **Pop-ups and redirects**.





6. Select "**Sites can send pop-ups and use redirects**"

Sites might send pop-ups to show ads, or use redirects to lead you to websites you may not want to visit

#### Default behavior

Sites automatically follow this setting when you visit them

-  Sites can send pop-ups and use redirects
-  Don't allow sites to send pop-ups or use redirects



## How to disable pop-up blockers using MS Edge:

1. Startup the Microsoft Edge browser on your PC/Laptop.
2. Click on the ' three-dot ' icon at the top right-hand side of the browser. 
3. Click on the ' Settings ' option from the drop-down menu. 
4. In the left pane, click on the ' Cookies and Site Permissions ' option. 
5. In the right-hand side pane, scroll down and click on the ' Popups and Redirects ' option. If blocked, then click on  slide "BLOCK" toggle to the off position.

## How to disable Pop-up Blockers using Safari (macOS):

Safari for macOS has no per-website control over blocking pop-up windows. Pop-ups are either blocked, or they are not. To allow pop-ups:

1. From the Safari menu, choose **Preferences...** and click the **Security** tab.
2. Ensure the **Block pop-up windows** option is not checked. Unchecking this option will allow pop-ups.
3. To block pop-ups once again, check the **Block pop-up windows** checkbox.
